

## **10 Common Idiomatic Expressions in Business**

- 1. **Green light** To have the go ahead/permission to start something.
- 2. **Hands are tied** To not have the authority to do that/answer that.
- 3. **No-brainer** It is the obvious way forward.
- 4. **Shoot something down** To disappoint the expectations of someone/to challenge the validity of an idea. (Similar to pick something apart)
- 5. **The elephant in the room** The problem or challenge that everyone is both aware of but avoids talking about.
- 6. **An uphill battle** It is a struggle/very difficult to complete something. It is not plain sailing!
- 7. **Rock the boat** To say or do something that challenges established norms/upsets people. (Similar idioms Ruffle a few feathers, step on a few toes).
- 8. **Flavour of the month** When something is temporarily fashionable/popular. Note this can be used critically.
- 9. **Fire fighter** Someone who is skilled and/or focused on solving problem.
- 10. **Bottleneck** When a process, decision or team activity is blocked. This can cause delays, incur additional costs.
